



# ADI Charter

The Association of Dental Implantology UK expects all Members to accept that:

- They will treat patients in line with current good practice and within their own competence level, maintaining good implant practice by continuing professional development
- They will ensure that all patients receive a written treatment plan in which the costs of that treatment are clearly shown
- They will ensure that the patient fully understands the treatment plan and gives appropriate consent prior to treatment
- They will use an evidence-based modern decision-making process in critically appraising new products and techniques before employing them in routine practice in accordance with current clinical consensus
- They will ensure that all equipment used is fit for purpose and properly maintained
- They will ensure proper post operative care, including an emergency contact number
- They will co-operate with referring dentists to ensure successful outcomes for the patient including appropriate maintenance
- They will keep a log of their implant cases and audit their implant practice regularly
